SBB Cargo International strengthens management team in Germany

SBB Cargo International is strengthening its subsidiary SBB Cargo Deutschland. It is appointing an additional executive manager to ensure that production is brought even more closely into line with market requirements and to accelerate response times. At the same time, management of administrative processes is being streamlined.

With driver availability becoming increasingly tight in Germany over the past year, the German subsidiary needs above all to be strongly positioned in terms of recruitment and training of railway staff. Matthias Birnbaum, Managing Director of SBB Cargo Deutschland, will be focusing on this area. He has therefore been tasked primarily with introducing more efficient processes, ensuring a sufficient supply of new train staff and managing the related financial resources. As executive manager of SBB Cargo International AG, he has also taken over responsibility for managing a strategic project.

To strengthen the new structure, Mr Götz Jesberg has been appointed to the executive management of SBB Cargo International's German arm as of 1 October 2016 as manager in charge of Production Germany/Netherlands and as member of the Management Board of SBB Cargo International AG.

By hiring Mr Jesberg, SBB Cargo International has recruited a well known figure from the world of freight transport. He is currently head of Dortmunder Eisenbahn, a company that operates as part of the Captrain Group throughout Germany.

Götz Jesberg was born in Essen on 12 January 1971. After completing his engineering studies, he successfully occupied a number of roles in the rail construction sector. He has been employed at Captrain Deutschland since 2008. Initially working as head of freight operations in the rail production area, he was responsible for the execution of freight services and for developing a marshalling platform for a north German industrial facility. Most recently, he was in charge of production and infrastructure at Dortmunder Eisenbahn.

With this new addition to its management team, SBB Cargo International is demonstrating its commitment to the company's further development in Germany.
