

I. Traction Power Germany

Electricity costs have increased many times over on the electricity markets since summer 2021, reaching historic highs from month to month.

SBB Cargo International has already secured a larger amount of electricity for calendar year 2023 through its procurement strategy in Germany. We pass this advantage on to our customers.

To ensure security of supply in 2023, SBB Cargo International will endeavour to purchase the remaining electricity for the German section of the route by the end of November.

Therefore, SBB Cargo International will introduce a new pricing model for traction current on the German section of the route as of 01.01.2023. This model consists of a fixed part (integrated in the train price) and an indexed part (traction power price surcharge).

A. Traction Power Price Surcharge Germany

For the calculation of the traction current price surcharge, the Destatis index value 35 11 15, "["erzeugerpreise-lange-reihen-xlsx-5612401.xlsx \(live.com\)"](#) is used.

Electric power special contract customers high voltage, is applied.

The electricity price factor is calculated as the difference between the average July through November 2022 index value and the January 2022 index value, divided by the January 2022 index value, which is 229.80 points.

The traction power price surcharge is equal to the product of the power price factor and the EUR amount of the indexed share of power DE.

The calculation results are rounded up or down to the nearest hundredth and the surcharge is rounded up to the nearest euro.

B. Implementation of Traction Power Price Surcharge Germany

The electricity price surcharge will be invoiced separately to the train price as of 1.1.2023. If the full index rate (July - November) is not available until January due to the December holidays, the implementation will be retroactive to 1.1.2023.

Upon presentation of written proof, SBB Cargo International will pass on any increase in traction current in other countries to the customer.
